LLC Managing Committee Meeting Agenda

- 1. Call to Order. Aaron Lange called the meeting to order at 3:09 PM.
- 2. **Approval of February 9 Agenda.** Bill Pauli moved to approve the February 9 meeting agenda, Nichola Hall second the motion. Motion was approved.
- 3. **Approval of January 25 Meeting Minutes.** Nichola Hall moved to approve the January 25 meeting minutes, Lise Asimont second the motion. Motion was approved.

4. Old Business

- a. **2019 Unified Program Development Committee (PDC) Chair.** Aaron Lange reviewed the Program Development Committee details provided in the packet, and reviewed who was on the list as chair, Keith Striegler, Julie Lumgair, and Tom Collins. Lise Asimont provided background regarding Julie Lumgair. John Aguirre stated that he reached out to Keith Striegler, he did not dismiss the idea and would be open to it. John Aguirre also stated that even though she would be interested in the future, Julie Lumgair is unable to agree to be chair for 2019 due her other commitments and limited availability with taking lead on a very large winemaking project.
 - i. **Discussion:** The committee felt that a Vice-Chair would be beneficial, it would provide a back-up and allow for mentorship, continuity and allow the person to transition into the chair role when the current chair is ready to step-down, with the caveat that the LLC Managing Committee reviews and approves each year, to see if it is still a good fit.
 - 1. Julie Lumgair is not quite ready to be chair in 2019, but she would be in the future and she could sit as the vice-chair. She would be a good fit as chair in the future. Aaron Lange made a recommendation to approve Julie Lumgair as vice-chair. The Program Development Committee needs new blood, and she would come to the table with organizational skill, energy, and connections.



- 2. **CalExpo**. The LLC Managing Committee feels that it would be beneficial to have someone on the committee, as chair, with the experience and history like Tom Collins has, with the transition to CalExpo.
- 3. Bill Pauli added Aaron Lange's name to the potential PDC chair list. Bill Pauli continued to state that Aaron Lange brings both sides to the table. However, Aaron Lange did politely decline for 2019 and stated that he would be more than happy to sit on the committee.
- 4. Bill Pauli made a motion to approve Tom Collins as the Program Development Chair for the 2019 Unified Wine & Grape Symposium, Nichola Hall second the motion. The motion is approved. Aaron Lange would like to make a motion, Lise Asimont moved, that we invite Julie Lumgair as vice-chair. Tom Slater second. The motion was approved. Tom Collins, as chair, is happy to reach out to Julie Lumgair to find out her availability and interest. John Aguirre will reach out to Keith Striegler, to let him know the direction of the chair. We do want him to come back to sit on the committee.

5. New Business

- a. **2019 Keynote Luncheon Speaker.** The LLC Managing Committee has decided not to invite Francis Ford Coppola back as Keynote Speaker, which will save us some time. Aaron Lange would like to see more of a business-like speaker, with more of a take-away, and a success story that you can bring into your own company. He stated that we should build a short list. We might want to look for someone in the spirits industry, or someone from outside of California in the wine industry.
